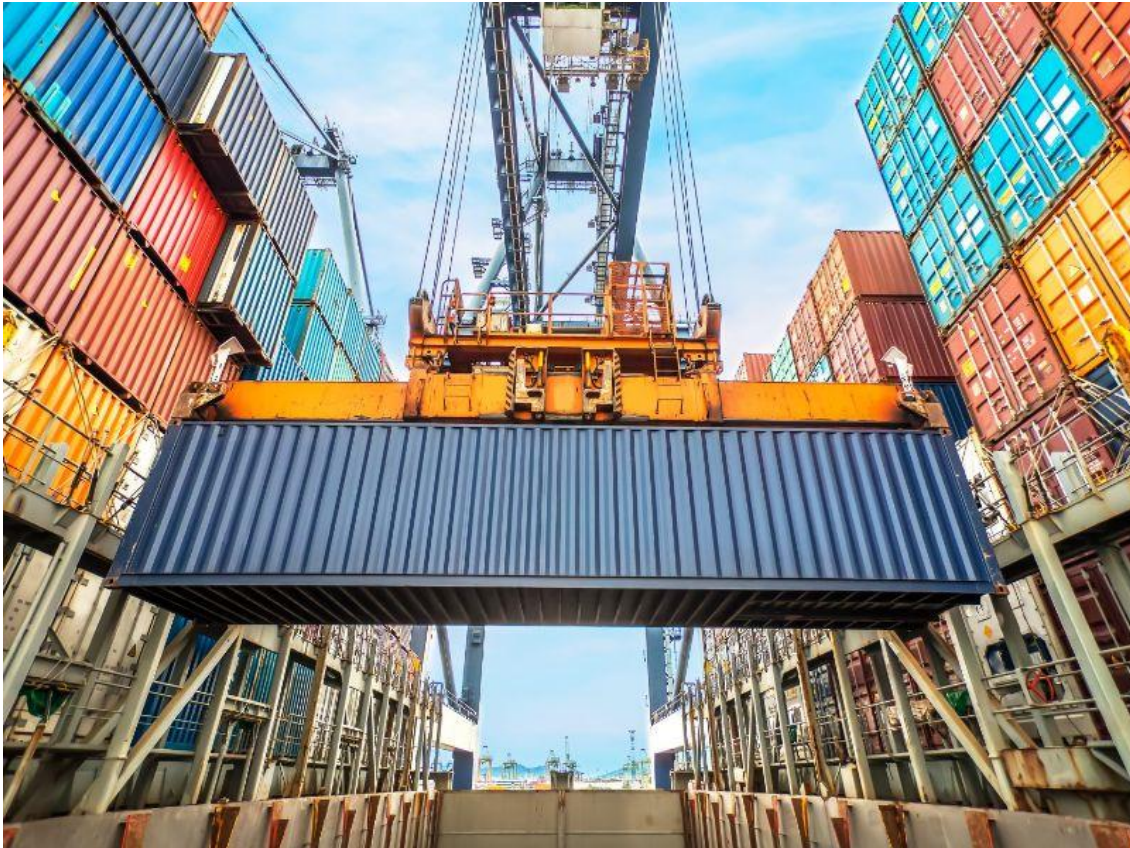
FIATA and UIC reinforce their longstanding partnership

CLECAT and FIATA call on OECD countries to include logistics services in the scope of the BEPS Pillar 2



FIATA and CLECAT (European Association for Forwarding, Transport, Logistics and Customs Services) welcome the historic proposals agreed upon by 130 countries under the OECD/G20 Inclusive Framework on Base Erosion Profit Shifting (BEPS) two-pillar plan for a global minimum corporation tax rate. Noting the proposed exemptions for shipping, CLECAT and FIATA raise concerns that the broad definition of 'shipping services', which currently includes ancillary services, would open the door to tax avoidance and trade distortion, undermining the overarching intent of the OECD/G20 BEPS framework.
