CLECAT POSITION ON SAFE & SECURE TRUCK PARKING AREA REGULATION

On 10 February, CLECAT submitted its input to the public consultation on the draft Delegated Regulation for Safe and Secure Truck Parking Areas (SSTPAs) in Europe, which enshrines the EU SSTPA Standard into legislation based on Article 8a of Regulation (EC) No 561/2006. The standard, which is based on four levels of security, a common level of service and certification procedures builds on the work of the 2019 Commission study on SSTPAs.

€30 MILLION SPANISH SCHEME TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO INTEROPERABILITY IN RAIL FREIGHT

On 9 February, the European Commission approved, under EU State aid rules, a €30 million Spanish scheme to remove barriers to interoperability in rei reight transport in Spain. The scheme will be funded through the Recovery and Resilience Facility ('RRF'), following the Commission's positive assessment of the Spanish Recovery and Resilience Plan and its adoption by Council.
