

- In addition to increasing the transparency of licensed freights, the BiReg system aims to effectively detect offenders.
- Foreign partners were notified immediately after the publication of the relevant legislation through both diplomatic and professional channels.
- Registration in the BiReg system is needed if a vehicle intends to enter the country and perform a licensed transport task. Registration can be started at any time.
- Government Decree 156/2009 (VII.29.) on the amount of fines that may be imposed in case of violation of certain provisions related to road haulage, passenger transport and road transport, as well as on the tasks of the authority related to fines, when the transport task, which must be subject to registration has not been registered. Consequently, the fine is linked to the transport task. Failure to register, but with proper permission, will allow the vehicle to proceed after securing the claim.
- 4 / A. § (2) of the Government Decree 261/2011: "the operator of the truck specified in subsection (1) or the carrier in the publicly accessible IT system operated by the transport authority (hereinafter: BIREG system) before the commencement of the transport task in Hungary or before entering the territory of Hungary - the data of the company such as details of the company name, registered office, activity or community license, and the data and rights of the users authorized to record the transport activity of the given company in the BIREG system (operator registration)." It is determined according to this provision against whom the administrative fine will be imposed.
