- Fast registration process
- Stability guarantees Provision of Tax stabilization certificate
- Flexibility and friendly conditions for investors



INVESTMENT PROTECTION COUNCIL

IPC which is headed by **Chief Cabinet Secretary** of Mongolia is built in **2016**.

- Preview and develop preliminary prognosis on foreign investment related issues to be discussed by Cabinet Session
- Protect investors' rights, solve their grievance (except the cases examined under court or arbitrage)
