WCEF Concept



- The World Circular Economy Forum presents the world's best circular economy solutions and gathers the most recognised experts and decision makers in the field. The aim is to accelerate the global transition towards a circular economy to achieve the UN Sustainable Development Goals.
- The WCEF event contains **high-level programme** with discussions, workshops, networking, side events and business excursions. The focus is on plenary/parallel sessions that cover different circular economy topics and bring business and the environment together, as well as encouraging networking between the participants.

- To help measure the impact of WCEF2023, partners will be asked to share a **post-event summary with key takeaways** (max 100 words) plus speaker and audience (registrations and participants) **statistics** (number, gender, nationality/country of residence) with Sitra



Responsibilities of Sitra



- **Co-ordinating the selection** of WCEF2023 Accelerator Sessions
- Linking together partners who are looking at similar themes
- **Sitra and WCEF2023 will promote** the Accelerator Sessions as an integral part of WCEF2023 programme





Facts and format

- Accelerator Sessions may take place on **1–2 June**.
- The sessions will be **live events** delivered **physically or virtually** at a venue or on a platform of the host's choice.
- Should be **open to the public**, but hosts may limit the number of participants.
- Should be **relevant to a global audience** but may feature **local** case studies and perspectives.
- **Recommended language is English**, but sessions may be delivered also in other languages. Simultaneous translation, if desired, will be the responsibility of the host.
- The **session host** has the main responsibility for **promoting the sessions**, so we strongly encourage the partners to use your own marketing channels.

- <u>Marina Congress Center</u> (Smaller meeting rooms and larger spaces. 25 min walk/12 min tram ride from the city centre.)
- <u>Musiikkitalo</u> (In the city centre.)
- <u>Clarion hotel</u> (Larger and smaller spaces. 25 min walk/ 11 min tram ride from the city centre.)
- <u>Sofia Helsinki</u> (Meeting rooms and workshop spaces. In the city centre.)
- <u>Meeting Park</u> (Workshop, meeting and seminar spaces. In the city centre.)
