

Participate in the survey on the national implementation of the WTO's TFA



The FIATA electronic Bill of Lading (eFBL) proof of concept was successfully concluded on 15 August, with both the technical and operational feasibility of the eFBL solution being confirmed. The thorough tests and feedback sessions which were organized with each of the participants allowed to further enhance the eFBL data model, as well as the different processes related to the issuance, amendment and verification of the electronic document.
