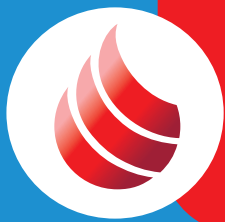


The TÜRKİYE EXECUTIVE RETREAT is now in its 4rd year.

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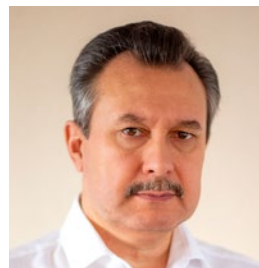

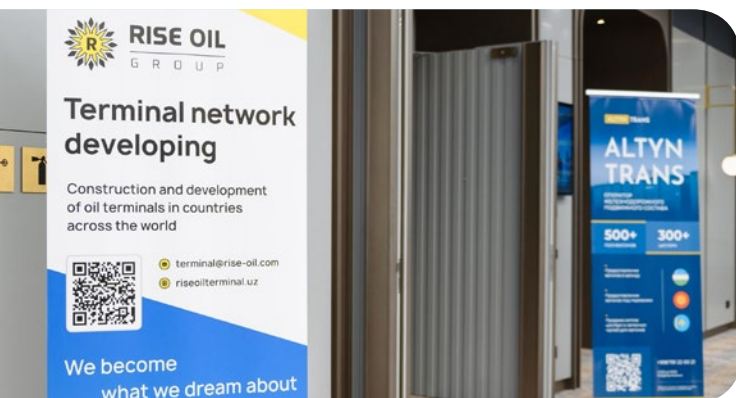
