

Dangerous Goods Air Transport Guidance During the COVID-19 Pandemic

Dear Industry Colleagues,

The COVID-19 pandemic has significantly disrupted the way the air transportation of dangerous goods is taking place.

In order to ensure the safe handling of dangerous goods in air shipping, IATA is pleased to offer, effective immediately, temporary access to DG AutoCheck including the online edition of the 61st DGR to freight forwarders. This trial offer is free of charge.

What is DG AutoCheck?

DG AutoCheck is a digital solution that assists airlines, ground handlers and freight forwarders in automatically checking the compliance of the Shipper's Declaration for Dangerous Goods (DGD) against all relevant provisions of the <u>IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations</u>. It also facilitates the verification of the packages' marks and labels on dangerous goods consignments. The online platform will also provide an online access to the 61st edition of the DGR manual.
